Tree Ordinance Panel of Municipal Arborist. Our panel of Municipal Arborist will share their do and don'ts when submitting a tree plan. The panel will then open up for questions. Neil Norton will moderate our panel; he is a consulting arborist and executive director of the Georgia Arborist Association. The panel of municipal arborist will include:

Chris Barneycastle of Barneycastle Forestry specializes in Tree Appraisal and expert witness testimony. Chris will discuss and review Council of Tree and Landscape Appraisers Guide for Plant appraisal and give a detailed overview of the process including a discussion of the four methods.

Neil Norton, is the Executive Director of the Georgia Arborist Association and a consulting arborist. Neil will tie together using tree value in tree ordinances. He has developed a matrix to qualitatively attribute a value to existing trees that can be applied to site plans by an arborist shortly after the property has been surveyed and before any building plans are designated.

Jesse Milton of One Bark is a master arborist that specializes in tree plans and tree construction. Over the years Jesse keeps a file on construction impact and common diseases by tree species. He will be unlocking the file to discuss 3 types of trees.
